Institutional Overview	<p>Xiamen University Malaysia (XMUM) is the pioneer Chinese university foreign branch campus set up and fully owned by Xiamen University, one of China's leading universities listed on the National Double First Class Initiative, which has been launched by the Chinese government to support selected universities in achieving world-class standing. Established upon the invitation of the Malaysian government, XMUM is the first overseas campus set up by a renowned Chinese university and the first Chinese university branch campus in Malaysia.</p> <p>As XMUM has been set up with the approval of both the Ministry of Education of the People's Republic of China (MOE China) and the Ministry of Higher Education Malaysia (MOHE Malaysia), XMUM has to follow and comply with the regulations set out by both MOE China and MOHE Malaysia. All students are admitted into XMUM through independent admissions, while students from the People's Republic of China (P.R. China) are admitted based on the National Higher Education Entrance Examination of China (Gaokao).</p>

GENERAL ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR MOBILITY STUDENTS

(1) Academic Requirements

Participating students should be selected by their home institution based on academic merit and suitability for the mobility programme, considering factors such as academic achievements, cultural adaptability, and overall physical and mental preparedness for the programme at XMUM. All candidates are subject to acceptance by XMUM and are expected to follow the standard application procedure, including submitting necessary documentation like an application form and academic transcripts.

(2) English Proficiency

As English serves as the medium of instruction for all courses at XMUM (excluding Traditional Chinese Medicine and Chinese Studies), proficiency in the language is essential for academic success. Applicants, particularly those whose first language is not English, are highly encouraged to provide an original or certified true copy of an International English Certificate (such as IELTS, TOEFL, or equivalent) or an English proficiency letter from their home university. This documentation should clearly indicate the applicant's English proficiency level to ensure effective understanding of course content and engagement in classroom activities.
