








## Campus

Nomination Deadline: May 15<sup>th</sup>, 2024
Application Deadline: May 31<sup>st</sup>, 2024

- Note: Before the application, we need to receive nomination lists by e-mail. After sending us the nomination lists, please send the original copies of application documents to the International Exchange Team by post(EMS). If original documents are not received by the deadline, application will not be accepted. Also, the documents must be sent by the institution, not the applicant himself or herself.

#### Academic Courses

Regular undergraduate course

Dong-eui University offers a variety of courses for exchange students. Basically, they can choose most of the courses except some particular courses like Korean Medicine, Nursing and etc. Please refer to the below departments lists:

 Korean Language & Literature, Chinese Language & Literature, Japanese Studies, English Language & Literature, Economics, Banking & Insurance, International Trade, Business Administration, International tourism Management, Hotel & Convention Management, Foodservice Management, etc.

## Korean Language Course

- Since most of the courses at our university are taught in Korean, DEU offers Korean Language Course for exchange students so that they can follow up the courses. They can take the Korean Language Course for free for the first semester. From the second semester, they can pay the tuition for the Korean language classes and take the course voluntarily.
- To assign them an appropriate class, a level test will be required before registration. Classes are held in either morning or afternoon classes, 4 hours a day, from Monday to Friday. After they complete the course, a certificate will be issued.
- Tuition fee information
  - KRW 1,800,000/semester(15 weeks, KRW 120,000/week)
  - additional 5 weeks: KRW 600,000(total 20 weeks)

## Buddy Program

Dong-eui University offers 'Buddy' program for exchange students to help them settle in Korea well. Exchange students and Korean students can exchange their languages and cultures mutually. Buddy students support various activities such as airport pick-up, on-campus and off-campus events, bank account and mobile phone opening, so that exchange students can adjust to school life in Korea.

- (8) Information sheet on Korean language study
- (9) Letter of recommendation
- (10) Identical full face 2 photos(3x4)

## Language Requirements

Dong-eui University does not require any language requirements for exchange students. However, <u>TOPIK level 3 or above is highly recommended</u> to take regular classes.

# **Exchange Duration**

• one semester or one year

#### Fees

- (1) Tuition fee: waived
- (2) Dormitory fee(can be changed)
  - The amount above is including deposit and 100 meal tickets.
  - The amount above is subject to change depending on the school circumstances.
  - Students from some universities are not required to pay the dormitory fee depending on the exchange agreement. In this case, we will inform you in advance.
- (3) National Health Insurance fee: about KRW 100,000 per month

## Dormitory

INFORMATION

- O Male students: The 1st Hyomin Dormitory(Building No. 24)
- O Female students: Women's Career Development Center (Building No. 13)
  - (1) Dormitory fee per semester:
    - Students who are from the universities that do not support the dormitory fee based on the agreement must pay the fee.
    - Students who are from the universities that support the dormitory fee based on the agreement, only pay the deposit and meal plans.
  - (2) payment period: please pay the fee the day you enter the dormitory (you need to inquire to the dormitory staff)
  - (3) Dormitory fee(can be changed)
